## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

**This cartridge is designed for use in a caulking gun. It contains sufficient for about a three metre run, which must then be coated with Rentokil Sealing Fluid.**

Horizontal surfaces on which birds settle should be treated so that birds attempting to alight or roost cannot avoid contact with the strip.

Where heavy fouling has occurred, remove deposits of droppings with a scraper before applying Bird Repellent Strip.

Bird Repellent Strip should be applied in parallel straight lines along ledges, sills and parapets. The outermost strip should be about two centimetres from the outer edge. In many cases this single line along the "alighting" edge effectively repels birds from roosting. In some cases, however, it is necessary to add further parallel strips at ten centimetre intervals, particularly along wide ledges.

The rate of extrusion must be fairly slow to ensure that the repellent strip deposited has a minimum thickness of eight millimetre; i.e. slightly thicker than a lead pencil.

### IMPORTANT

It is a legal requirement, under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, that every length of Bird Repellent Strip must be completely sealed to reduce risk of birds becoming entangled in the strip or picking it up on their feathers. Sealing must be carried with Rentokil Sealing Fluid.
