

# Rentokil **DEADLINE**®

## For the control of rats and mice in both indoor and outdoor situations

Contains 0.005% w/w bromadiolone

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Deadline is a ready-to-use rodenticide for professional use against rats and mice. Bait labels must be affixed to any decanting bucket or vessel into which bait is transferred prior to its placement at bait points.

Once the rodent population is completely controlled, do not place further rodenticide until a new infestation is identified.

**FOR RATS:** Use 50-500g (depending on infestation level). **FOR MICE:** Use up to 10g bait in a bait box or tray. More bait may be used in exceptional circumstances where there is heavy infestation.

Always protect baits well so as to protect from the prevailing weather and to prevent access by humans, domestic animals and wildlife.

**For indoor use** - position in protected locations where mice or rats are running and feeding e.g. under cupboards, behind furniture or in loft spaces. **For outdoor use** - position in protected locations where mice or rats are running and feeding e.g. in lengths of pipe or beneath tiles leant against a wall.

Inspect bait at appropriate intervals and replenish until no more bait is taken.

Product may be used in damp conditions.

The resistance status of the target population should be taken into account when considering the choice of rodenticide to be used.

### ADVICE TO DOCTOR

Bromadiolone is an indirect anticoagulant. Phytomenadione, Vitamin K1, is antidotal. Determine prothrombin times not less than eighteen hours after consumption. If elevated, administer Vitamin K1 until prothrombin time normalises. Continue determination of prothrombin time for two weeks after withdrawal of antidote and resume treatment if elevation occurs in that time.
